THE NEED



Though over 19 million Americans struggled with substance addiction in 2025, only a small fraction received treatment.

In Skagit County and nationwide, fentanyl remains the primary threat, as the main driver of overdose fatalities. Fentanyl is often mixed into other substances like cocaine and methamphetamine without the user's knowledge, making the drug supply more dangerous. In addition, use of methamphetamine and cocaine is increasing, due to low cost, high potency, and use as a coping mechanism for stress.

Because of soaring rental costs and limited spaces, those who attend treatment often have nowhere to go afterward, making our program of entry-level and second-step homes—which do not limit length of stay—a critical part of the healing process.

WHAT CAUSES HOMELESSNESS?

Most of us have opinions about the root causes of homelessness. We believe it's caused by social policies, addiction, mental illness, poverty, racial bias, and even the climate of certain locations. In the book *Homelessness Is a Housing Problem*, Gregg Colburn looks at each of these factors--and, one by one, eliminates each as a primary cause. The final inescapable conclusion is that the availability and cost of housing is the only significant predictor of whether a community will experience a homelessness crisis.

In the Skagit Valley, housing is expensive and hard to find. Thus, we have a challenging homelessness problem. We as a community started addressing the issue far too late to avoid the crisis. But we can work toward resolving these issues in big and small ways.

What we're doing at NER is making a difference. We can house 59 people, most of whom did not have a housing plan before they came to us to work on their recovery. Our residents are healing, building a foundation of recovery, learning life and job skills, moving closer to full employment, and taking other steps to make it more likely they will find a sustainable life when they step out from under our roof.

“ After years of homelessness and the prison system, this program has been such a huge blessing.


